Your brain controls what you do by sending tiny electrical messages you can't feel all around your body.

Epilepsy is a medical condition that affects the

brain.


### People with Epilepsy suffer from seizures.



When someone has a seizure their brain has a sudden burst of activity that starts to send too many messages.

During a seizure, the messages get jumbled up and cause the body to do unusual things.













- Stay with the person
- When they stop moving around, roll them on the side to help them breath
  - · If you can't find an adult, call 911

# Here are things not to do

- · crowd around them
- ASK Me Why

- ignore them
- · do not panic or shout



Purple is the colour of epilepsy!








